<u>Trigram pattern</u>: Top line is broken - - , middle line is broken - - , bottom line is solid ____ . Represents the concept of KAN. Kan symbolizes a mountain peak... which is solid, stable and unmovable. This poomsae teaches commitment to both motion and immobility, with rapid movements forward followed by sudden stops.
